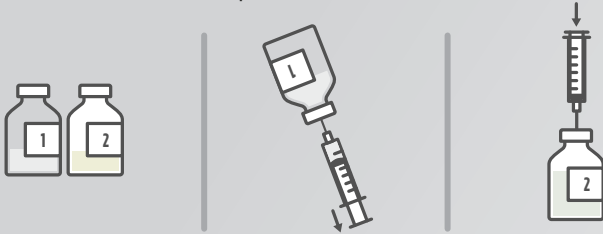


HOW TO PREPARE AND ADMINISTER INFORCE 3[®] INTRANASAL VACCINE

INFORCE 3[®] helps stimulate a robust immune response to help provide rapid protection from key viral respiratory diseases. Follow these steps to correctly prepare and administer the intranasal vaccine.

PREPARE THE VACCINE

- 1** Aseptically rehydrate the freeze-dried vaccine with the sterile diluent provided.



- 2** Shake gently until well mixed.



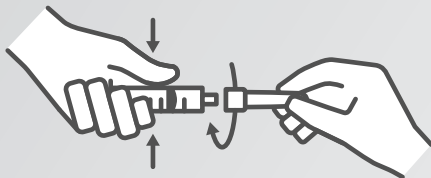
- 3** Sterile syringes and needles should be used to reconstitute INFORCE 3[®]. Do not sterilize with chemicals because traces of disinfectant may inactivate the vaccine.



- 4** Fill sterile syringe with 2 mL of vaccine.



- 5** Remove needle from the syringe.



- 6** **OPTIONAL:** If you decide to use a cannula, attach a new one to the end of the syringe.



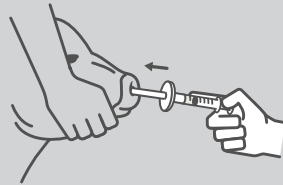
NOTE: You can also administer INFORCE 3[®] using a syringe with the needle removed.

ADMINISTER THE VACCINE

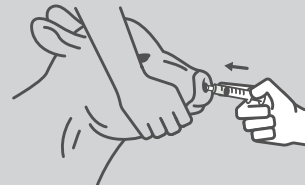
- 1** Hold the animal's head in a normal, upright position.



- 2A** If using a cannula, insert cannula straight into the nostril along the floor of the nasal cavity and administer the vaccine.



- 2B** If using a syringe (without a needle and without a cannula), insert syringe into the nostril and administer the vaccine.



- 3** **For 1-nostril administration:** Administer 2 mL of vaccine into 1 nostril.

For 2-nostril administration: Administer 1 mL of vaccine into each nostril.



Vaccination technique is successful when the vaccine comes into contact with mucous membranes in the animal's nasal cavity. You do not need to re-vaccinate if the animal sneezes or vaccine drips from its nose.
